



TORTONA GREEN LOGISTICS PARK

Connected for a more sustainable future



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1. THE PROJECT

The **Tortona Green Logistics Park** is a logistics project located in the Piedmont province of northwest Italy, on a site covering a total area of 394,750 sqm.

The project, consisting of two state-of-the-art warehouses, has a total buildable area of 153,236 sqm, located at a key logistics point between the A7 and A21 highways.

The Tortona Green Logistics Park, like all of our logistics projects, is being developed following strict energy efficiency sustainability standards in the supply chain and in construction

in order to reduce ${\rm CO_2}$ emissions. The project features green and sustainability certification and the installation of rooftop photovoltaic panels.

- Tortona Green Logistics Park I was delivered in late 2022 and is now fully let. It has LEED Gold sustainable construction certification.
- Tortona Green Logistics Park II will be available from Q4 2024

Building construction to a high standard of international sustainability certification (i.e. BREEAM, LEED).



2. STRATEGIC LOCATION

The **Tortona Green Logistics Park** is located in the comune of Tortona (Alessandria), a prime location for logistics operations. The warehouses are strategically located between the A7 and A21 highways and are well-connected to several major cities in Italy, including Milan (75 km), Genoa (73 km) and Turin (108 km). In addition, the Park is located close to major railway lines.






3. ACCESS AND PLOT LAYOUT

Tortona I, the first phase of the Tortona Green Logistics Park project, was constructed on a 129,020 sqm plot and delivered in 2022. This state-of-the-art logistics development has a total GLA of 51,596 sqm and is now fully let.

The **Tortona Green Logistics Park II** asset consists of a warehouse with a GLA of 101,640 sqm sited on a 265,730 sqm plot, offering customisation possibilities adapted to the needs of its tenants.

5. SUSTAINABILITY

Aquila Group has the mission to become one of the worlds' leading sustainable investment and development companies for essential assets by 2030. Essential assets are those related to expanding or renovating the world's low-carbon infrastructure. In addition, the design and construction of our projects under the highest standards of energy efficiency and sustainability allow us to help our tenants comply with their ESG and CSR policies.

By implementing sustainable, energy-efficient building practices and allowing ESG criteria to guide our investments, we are not only helping to chart a new course for the ongoing development of the logistics sector towards improved sustainability, but also actively involved in meeting the challenge of Europe's 2030 energy transition targets.
